Introduction

Save HIV Funding Campaign offers this list of key Congressional offices to help identify important lawmakers to contact and educate about HIV funding issues through:

- *in-district meetings or events* with local advocates
- *DC-based meetings or events* with local and national advocates
- *Contact by phone & email*, including via action alerts

The list was developed through an assessment of key factors, including Congressional committee and HIV Caucus membership; interest in HIV and healthcare issues; election status; representation of states cutting or containing costs for HIV programs (including ADAP); position on Medicaid; and other related issues. Please also note that this list likely will be updated over the coming months. Finally, please contact Bill McColl (bmccoll@colliercollective.org) from Collier Collective if you believe a Representative or Senator should be added to this list or you plan to meet with that office, thanks.

And while long, this list is *not* meant to be exhaustive. **We strongly urge people to continue to engage and educate their two Senators and local Representative from Congress - even if they are not on this list.**

Using the List

Please note that the list indicates for each Congressional office:

- The state affiliation
- Whether the member is a Senator or Representative
- The district for each Representative
- Party membership
- Hyperlinks to each Congressional member's website (to provide info such as the member's bio, priorities, office locations, district map, etc.)

Please check the list for members of Congress from your state:

- **If a Senator and/or Representative (or one nearby) is listed - or a member who has a constituency served by HIV programs in your state - the Save HIV Funding campaign urges you to please *request a meeting* or *invite that member and/or someone from their local staff to an event*.**
- **Check out the office's website** for contact info and office locations.

- **Call or email the office to request the name and contact info** for the State Director (for Senators) or District Director (for Representatives) so that you can request a meeting or invite them to a local event.
 - **Request info for the Scheduler** if you would like to request a meeting directly with or to invite *the Senator or Representative*.
